Building Support for Development
Objective 1: To ensure that global issues are adequately incorporated in curriculum provision and guidance across the UK.
 TLM Objectives 1, 2, 3, 4 & 6

* Six link primary schools will become Centres of Excellence, integrating the global dimension across the curriculum.
 * Centres of Excellence will mentor other schools, lead training and share good practice on curriculum development.
 * Professional development materials will be produced to support teachers to understand global issues and enable schools to incorporate the global dimension across the curriculum.

Building Support for Development
Objective 2: To ensure provision of good quality materials and resources to facilitate teaching in schools.
 TLM Objectives 2 & 6

* A resource centre in Peterborough will be expanded to provide schools in the surrounding area with access to development education resources that support the teaching of the global dimension.
 * The project will work with link-schools/partners to trial and evaluate existing resources and produce good quality Continual Professional Development (CPD) materials so support schools to integrate the global dimension into the primary curriculum.

Building Support for Development
Objective 3: To reinforce the school-based work through the teacher training, inspection and awarding bodies.
 TLM Objectives 3, 4 & 6

* Local authority consultants and advisers in Peterborough (many of whom are registered OFSTED inspectors) will receive training.
 * Schools will be encouraged to work towards the International Schools Award.

Building Support for Development
Objective 4: To encourage whole school or community based activities with a development focus.
 TLM objectives 3, 4, 5 & 6

* Training and in-school support from advisers and consultants will emphasise the importance of developing a whole school approach to the global dimension.
 * Pupil Millennium Development Goal (MDG) Action Groups will support children to develop a global dimension to their decision making and raise the awareness of their peers and community of global issues.
 * Community knowledge, skills and understanding of global diversity will be shared.

TLM Objective 1
 To ensure teachers have the knowledge skills and understanding to develop creative strategies to integrate the global dimension across the primary curriculum.

TLM Objective 3
 To ensure primary strategy consultants, advisers and leading teachers in Peterborough LA have an increased understanding of how to support teachers/headteachers to develop the global dimension across the curriculum.

TLM Objective 4
 To develop six 'Centres of Excellence' – schools that share good practice, creatively integrating the global dimension across the primary curriculum.

TLM Objective 5
 To ensure pupils and teachers are more aware of how The Leprosy Mission, other NGOs and the government are contributing to the achievement of the Millennium Development Goals; and of their own role in supporting development.

TLM Objective 2
 To enable Peterborough schools to have improved access to resources and training that supports the teaching of the global dimension.

Aim
 To mobilise and build the capacity of primary school teachers in Peterborough to integrate the global dimension into teaching, providing children with a creative curriculum that supports them to understand global issues and how they impact on their lives and the lives of others.
